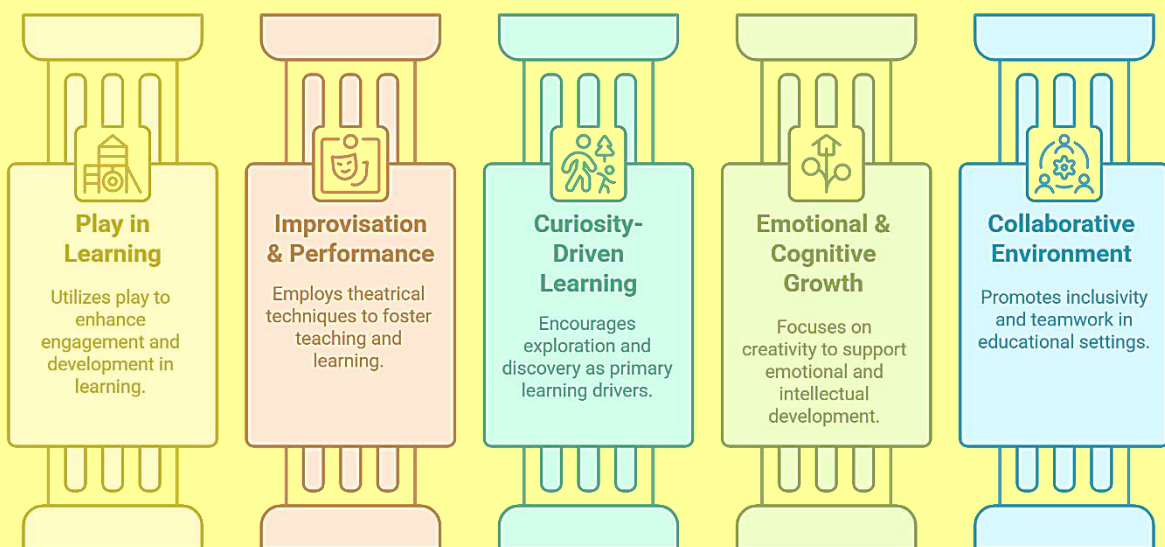

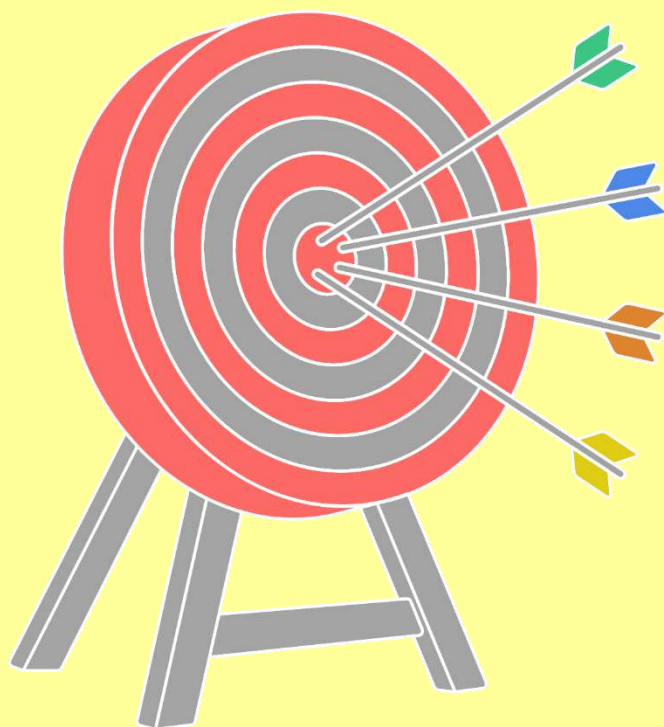
About the Workshop

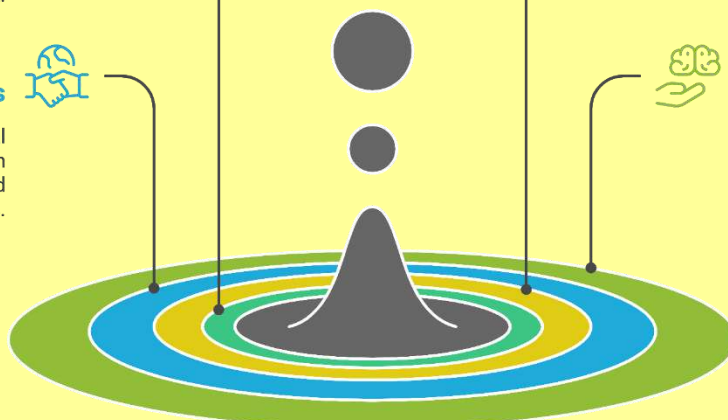
