ANNUAL REPORT 2020 –21

Academics During Pandemic:

The college adopted a number of steps to adapt to the pandemic scenario of academic year 2020 –21. The **classes were held in the online mode** through Google meet according to the usual full routine of offline sessions. The students and teachers aided each other in successful conducting of online classes. **Youtube** channel was launched during the pandemic and lectures by teachers were uploaded there for the ready reference of the students. **E** –**content** was uploaded to the **updated website**. WhatsApp groups were created for all classes to facilitate easy interaction and exchange of material between teachers and students.

A total of four **Memoranda of Understanding** for faculty exchange were carried out with four Kolkata colleges to provide wider teaching —learning exposure for students and staff. The exchange classes were successfully held in the online mode.

Academic and administrative audit for 2020 –21 was carried out with the help of three Principals from different Kolkata colleges. The feedback was taken into account for further academic and administrative improvement.

Extra -curricular and Co -curricular Activities:

The tradition of annual publication of the college magazine, **Suparna**, was maintained during the pandemic through its publication in the **e** –**magazine** format.

The institution celebrated and organized important national and international days, events and festivals throughout the year in a planned way, mostly in the online mode to tide over the pandemic situation. In the year 2020 –21, **Saraswati puja/ Basanta Utsav** was celebrated online. The IQAC and Bengali Department celebrated the **International Mother Language Day** on 21st February 2021 in an online platform. 95 participants were present and a lecture was delivered by renowned Indian historian, writer and Indologist, Nrisingha Prasad Bhaduri. Inter college competitions of English and Bengali essay writing and photography were organized by the IQAC on the occasion of **International Women's Day** on 8th March, 2021. 71 students participated in the competitions from several colleges. The Go Green club of Muralidhar Girls' College collaborated with the Departments of Botany and Environmental Sciences to celebrate **World Environment Day** on 5th June, 2021. Drawing and photography competitions were

organised on themes like waste management, water loss management, plantation, gardening, limiting of plastic use, to encourage environmental awareness among students. Winners were announced accordingly.

Activities:

Green audit was carried out with the help of Global EHS Consultants in order to analyse environmental practises in the college and identify areas where greener alternatives can potentially be adopted, for the purpose of building a sustainable future for our students and instill in them environmental awareness.

8 **Add on** courses were conducted to update vocational skills of the students and a total of 438 students attended.

Online activities such as online self defence classes, online yoga classes were organized regularly during the pandemic.

Library:

Semester-wise three WhatsApp groups were created with the class representatives of all departments. Soft copy documents are being supplied according to the students need. Students are also encouraged to use the online database Nlist. Separate user ids have been assigned to them. 11 Journals are subscribed by the library which is accessible online also.

Results:

192 Honours students appeared in their final B.A Part III Examination. Out of 192 students 190 of them passed their examination where 51 students secured first class. From B.Sc. Honours 58 students appeared and passed the exam where 36 students secured first class. 11 students from B.A Part III Major appeared and passed the examination with 8 students securing first class. On the other hand, 96 students passed their B.A General Part III examination out of 99 students who appeared in the exam. Lastly from B.Sc. General Part III examination 21 students appeared and passed the examination with 3 students securing first class.

NSS Activities:

In order to address the crisis of the pandemic, NSS undertook a number of activities. A helpline was instituted by NSS and Department of Bengali. It provided vital information regarding oxygen, medicines, doctors,hospital beds, food and other essentials. Masks, face shields, sanitizers were distributed for officers of local police station for their use and distribution in community. During the pandemic situation the college distributed masks, sanitizer and face shields to the officers of Gariahat police station. A webinar on health issues was organized. An online quiz competition was held on World Youth Day on 12th January.
