

PROGRAMME SPECIFIC OUTCOMES (PSOs)

After successful completion of 3-Year: 6-Semester Honours Programme in Political Science, a student should be able to achieve the following:

PSO1	Knowledge of Political System: Political Science is the scientific study of politics. It enables the students to acquire knowledge about systems of governance and power, and the analysis of political activities, political institutions, political thought and behaviour, and associated constitutions, laws and global politics.
PSO2	Development Perspectives with emphasis on Indian polity: From a development perspective, Indian politics focuses on welfare schemes and policies which help in greater inclusion of the marginalised people and results in holistic development of the state.
PSO3	Application of qualitative and quantitative research methods: Qualitative and Quantitative research methods are used in social science as well as political science. Use of statistical theory, (such as game theory, Public choice theory, decision making theory), data analysis, polling survey, legislative survey, policy based mathematical analysis are increasingly used in study of political science.
PSO4	Research Aptitude: The course equips students with the aptitude for research.
PSO5	Socio-Economic Awareness: It makes students aware about political and social problems confronting the state and the world at large.
PSO6	Higher Education & Employability: A disciplinary knowledge of Political Science enables the students to pursue a career in civil service, journalism, academics, advertising among others
