# Admission to Semester-Wise 3-Year B.A. / B.Sc. Honours 2021-2022 Under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) Conducted by the University of Calcutta

#### **OUTLINE OF CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM**

Academic Year: Two consecutive (one odd + one even) semesters constitute one academic year.

Course: Usually referred to, as 'papers' is a component of a programme. All courses need not carry the same weight. The courses should define learning objectives and learning outcomes. Different courses may have different marks. A course may be designed to comprise lectures / tutorials / laboratory work / field work / outreach activities / project work / vocational training / viva / seminars / term papers / assignments / presentations/self-study etc. or a combination of some of these.

I. <u>CORE COURSE (CC):</u> A course, which should compulsorily be studied by a candidate as a core requirement is termed as a Core course.

#### Modalities of selective CC by a student of Honours programme shall be as follows:

In case of B.A. / B.Sc. Honours programme a student shall have to study 14 Core courses (CC1-CC14) of the Honours Subject as specified for each of the 6 semesters.

- II. <u>ELECTIVE COURSE</u>: Generally a course which can be chosen from a pool of courses and which maybe very specific or specialized or advanced or supportive to the discipline / subject of study or which provides an extended scope or which enables an exposure to some other discipline / subject / domain or nurtures the candidate's proficiency / skill is called an Elective Curse.
  - i) <u>DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC ELECTIVE (DSE) COURSE</u>: An elective course which may be offered by the main discipline / subject of study is referred to as Discipline Specific Elective. This course is to advance knowledge and skill in the core course domain.

#### Modalities of selecting DSE by a student of Honours programmes hall be as follows:

In case of B.A. / B.Sc. Honours programme a student shall have to study 4 DSE courses strictly on the Honours subject. Such a student shall have to study the curriculum of DSE on the Honours subject concerned as specified for the relevant semester. Each Honours subject shall have two groups (A & B) of DSE papers. A student shall choose any one paper from each of Group A and Group B in fifth semester and sixth semester.

<u>Dissertation / Project</u>: A elective course designed to acquire special / advanced knowledge, is termed as dissertation / project. This is considered as a special course involving application of knowledge in solving / analyzing / exploring a real life situation / difficult problem. A dissertation / project work will be of 6 credits. A dissertation / project work may be given in lieu of a Discipline Specific Elective.

**ii) GENERIC ELECTIVE (GE) COURSE:** An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline / subject, with an intention to seek wide exposure, is called Generic Elective.

#### Modalities of selecting GE by a student of Honours programme shall be as follows:

In case of B.A./B.Sc. Honours programme, a student shall have to choose 4 Generic Elective papers strictly from 2 subjects of choice taking exactly two courses from each subject as specified for first 4 semesters.

- III. <u>ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COURSES (AEC)</u>: The Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC).
  - i) <u>ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COMPULSORY COURSES (AECC)</u>: AECC courses are the courses based uopn the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement. These are mandatory for all disciplines.
  - a) AECC1: Communicative English / MIL (Bengali);
  - b) AECC2: Environmental Studies
  - **ii) SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSES (SEC)**: These courses may be chosen from a pool fo courses designed to provide value-based and / or skill-based knowledge and are aimed at providing competencies, skills, etc.

#### Modalities of selecting SEC by a student of Honours programmes hall be as follow:

In case of B.A. / B.Sc. Honours programme a student shall have to study 2 skill enhancement courses strictly on the Honours subjects. Such a student shall have to study the curriculum of SEC on the Honours subjects concerned as specified for the relevant semester, i.e., SEC-A in the  $3^{rd}$  semester and SEC-B in the  $4^{th}$  semester. Each Honours subject shall have two groups (A & B) of Skill Enhancing Course papers. An Honous student shall have to choose one paper from Group A in third semester and one paper from Group B in fourth semester.

<u>PRACTICAL / TUTORIAL</u>: Every Core, Discipline Specific and Generic Elective Course shall have a Practical / Tutorial component. Wherever there is a practical, there will be no Tutorial and vice-versa.

<u>Dissertation/Project</u>: An elective course designed to acquire special / advanced knowledge, is termed as dissertation / project. This is considered as a special course involving application of knowledge in solving / analyzing / exploring a real life situation / difficult problem. A dissertation / project work will be of 6 credits. A dissertation / project work may be given in lieu of a Discipline Specific Elective.

**ii) GENERIC ELECTIVE (GE) COURSE:** An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline / subject, with an intention to seek a wide exposure, is called a Generic Elective.

#### Modalities of selecting GE by a student of Major programme shall be as follows:

In case of B.A. (Major) programme, a student shall have to choose 4 Generic Elective papers strictly from 2 subjects of choice taking exactly two courses from each subject as specified for first 4 semesters.

N.B.: A core course offered in a discipline/subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/subject and such electives may also be referred to as Generic Elective. [A Core Course (CC) of B.A. (General) may be treated as Generic Elective for B.A. (Major)].

- C) ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COURSES (AEC): The Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC) may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC).
  - a) <u>ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COMPULSORY COURSES (AECC)</u>: AECC courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement. These are mandatory for all disciplines.
    - i) AECC1: Communicative English/MIL(Bengali);
    - ii) AECC2: Environmental Studies.
  - **b) SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSES (SEC)**: These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge and are aimed at providing competencies, skills, etc.

#### Modalities of selecting SEC by a student of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com (Major) programme shall be as follows:

In case of B.A. (Major) programme a student shall have to study 2 Skill Enhancement Courses strictly on the Major subject. Such a student shall have to study the curriculum of SEC on the Major subject concerned as specified for the relevant semester, i.e., SEC-A in the 3rd semester and SEC-B in the 4th semester. The Major subject shall have two groups (A & B) of SEC papers. A student shall have to choose one paper from Group A in third semester and one paper from Group B infourth semester.

<u>PRACTICAL / TUTORIAL</u>: Every Core Course, Discipline Specific Elective and Generic Elective Course shall have a Practical/Tutorial component. Wherever there is a practical, there will be no Tutorial and vice-versa.

#### ADMISSION TO B.A. (Major) - TTMV - 2021-22:

A candidate who secures a minimum of 45% (40% for candidates belonging to SC/ST community) marks in the aggregate at the H.S. (10+2) or in an equivalent examination shall be eligible for admission to the B.A.(Major) Degree Course of Study in Tourism & Travel Management (TTMV), provided she has passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.

For the purpose of determining eligibility to TTMV Course, aggregate shall be calculated by adding the marks in Top-Four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate in H.S. (10+2) or in an equivalent examination.

Marks in compulsory Environmental Education/Studies / Science shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. However Environmental Education/Studies / Science if studied as an Elective subject of 100 marks may be considered.

<u>Candidates taking up TTMV B.A. (Major) Degree Course shall study any two of the following as Compulsory Generic</u> Elective Subjects.
