INTRODUCTION

Muralidhar Girls' College had its moment of inception in 1919 when Sri Muralidhar Bandyopadhyay, the Principal of Sanskrit College and a well-known educationist and reformer whose goal was to open the door for women to pursue higher education, established a Girls' school. His goal came true on July 8, 1940, when the school changed its name to Ballygunge Girls' College. In 1946, it was renamed Muralidhar Girls' College in commemoration of its founder.

The motto of this college is "Atmadipobhava," which aims to shine your inner light on everything around you. It focuses on the growth of a fully realized woman who is knowledgeable, honest, and utterly compassionate human. Building on its long-standing tradition of empowering women, the college serves as a driving force for social change, nurturing independent scientific thinking, intellectual engagement with societal issues, and a steadfast dedication to gender equality among its students.

Under sections 2f and 12B of the UGC Act 1956, the four-story college building, located on Gariahat Road in the centre of the city, is included among the UGC panel of recognized colleges. Additionally, it is registered under the 1961 West Bengal Societies Registration Act. The college occupies 0.25253 acres of land in total. There are 3134.5 square meters of developed space overall.

MILESTONES FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2023 -24:

- The college received a NAAC Accredited A grade for maintaining the standard of quality maintenance in all areas of the college.
- A formal Incubation Centre was established, following the IQAC's proposal on April 19, 2023, based on recommendations from the Academic and Administrative Audit team.
- With funds from the RUSA fund, the college built a new four-story annexure building to improve academic and administrative facilities and extend infrastructure.
