
### 14<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2020: WEBINAR ON HEALTH ISSUES DURING COVID PANDEMIC



### Distribution of masks and sanitizers by NSS units (September 2020)

To control the spread of COVID-19, wearing masks is important. Protective masks are said to lower the chances of coronavirus entering our respiratory system through droplets that are present in the air. Wearing of masks is especially recommended for people living in densely populated areas. Another important precautionary measure in Covid pandemic is frequent Washing of hands with plain soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, it is highly recommended to use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60 percent alcohol. Police/security personnel are in continuous exposure and close contact with public, who could be potentially infective to others. Therefore, the NSS units of the college has organised face Shields, masks and sanitizers distribution programme for the officers of local police station for their own use as well as distribution in the community September 2020.
